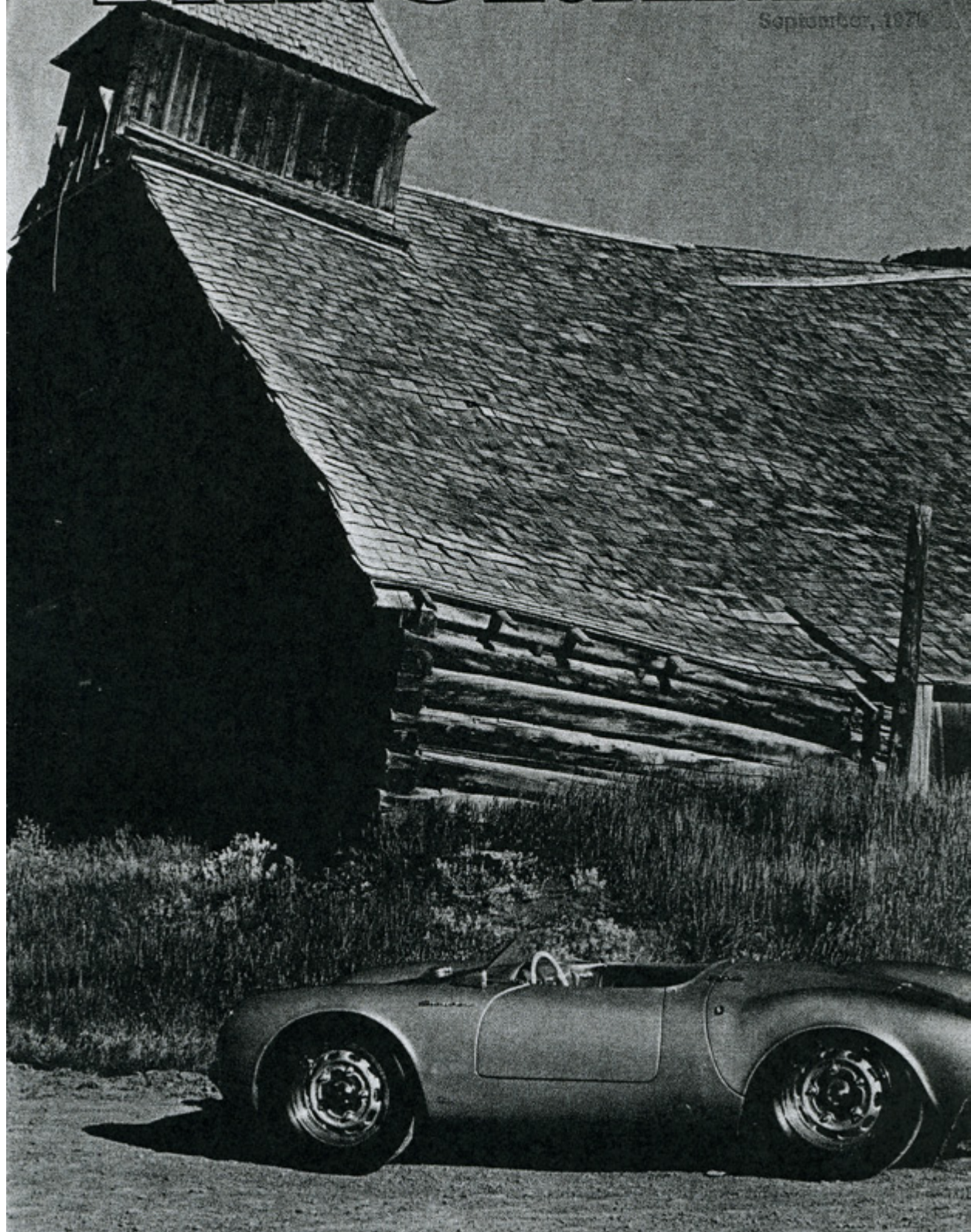

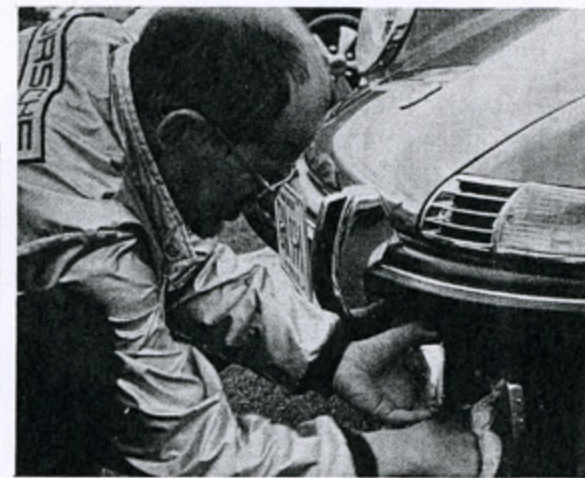

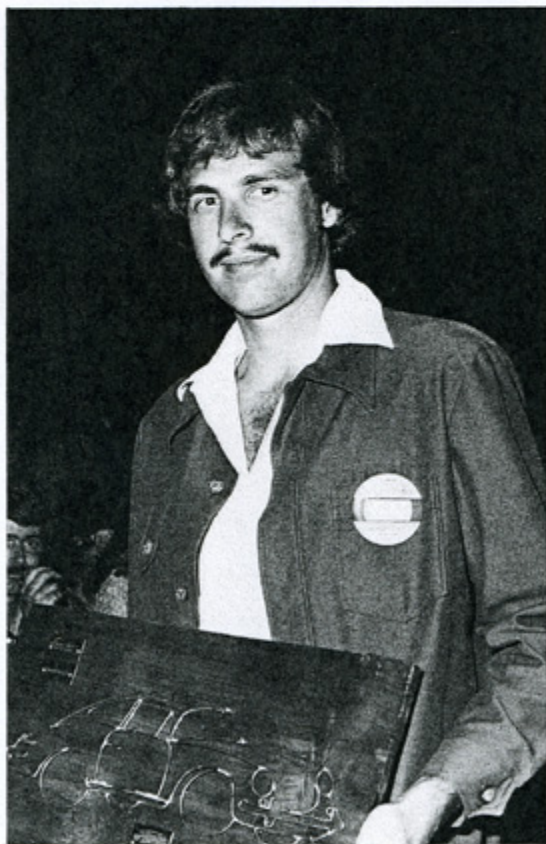
Louise and Josef Ahorner, fourth generation members of the Porsche family, were honored guests at Snowmass.
